

## **Terminal Controller / Shift Lead – Permanent Position – Marsden Point**

We're looking for a permanent Terminal Controller to control and supervise 24/7 operations and perform quality control at the terminal while ensuring uninterrupted plant availability to meet customer commitments. This requires disciplined execution of routine operational and maintenance tasks to maintain EHS Compliance, technical integrity, and rigorous controls during non-routine activities. This role is shift work on a 5-week rotational roster which means you will be required to work more than 40 hours in some weeks. However, the average hours worked per week over a 12-month period will be no more than 40 hours.

Core Duties include (but not limited to):

- Responsible for coordinating site operational activities on shift to meet customer commitments, including communicating with the Terminal Scheduler and other parties involved
- Responsible for all panel operations including ship to shore transfers, Terminal to Auckland pipeline and truck loading facility transfers.
- Shift leadership responsible for emergency management, execution of operations and maintenance plans escalating issues to duty management staff as required.
- Assist with Shore Officer duties for shipping planning, supervision of shipping activities as required.
- Permit Authoriser on Shift
- Responsible for the monitoring, operation, testing and release of site storm water, groundwater and other site environmental systems providing samples for specialist testing where required.
- On shift operational and maintenance planning and execution of the plans relating to operations, plan and supervise labour allocations.
- Lead shift team activities to optimize equipment and facilities while minimizing safety and environmental impacts.
- Develop other operators through effective skill coaching and mentoring as required.
- Participate in the training of shift personnel within the team.
- Communicate with engineers, maintenance technicians and other team members to assist in identifying maintenance issues and planning and scheduling maintenance activities.
- Responsible for the product preparation, sampling, testing and release. Ensuring product is tested (by either terminal staff or independent laboratory) and on specification before release for dispatch.

We mentioned 24/7 operations, and need you to be adaptable, so that does mean we need people who are happy to do shift work. In return we'll invest in you by providing comprehensive training and development, and room to grow in a work environment that is inclusive and diverse – a place where you can be yourself, problem solve and share your ideas.
