

Pipeline Engineer

Channel Infrastructure - New Zealand's leading fuel infrastructure company is the essential connection in New Zealand's energy network. We receive, store, test, and distribute transport fuels safely, reliably, and efficiently to the Northland and Auckland markets. At our Marsden Point site, we store up to 280 million litres of fuel which is delivered via our 170 kilometre pipeline directly to Auckland.

Currently we are recruiting for a Pipeline Engineer to join our Channel Terminal Services (CTS) Ruakaka to Auckland Pipeline (RAP) Team. We're looking for people who are proactive, resourceful and highly motivated.

Working with the Pipeline Manager, this role will be responsible for the ongoing daily practical management of pipeline safety and integrity management activities such as inspections, compliance audits and multi-agency emergency exercises, as described in the CTS Pipeline Management System. Accountabilities include (but are not limited to):

- Plan and coordinate all regular maintenance activities including; all mechanical, electrical, instrument and civil tasks plus any remedial work associated with the assets which incorporate the pipeline, pump stations and valve sites (primarily utilising outside contractors).
- Implement and directly supervise/undertake pipeline projects and maintenance activities including where applicable; isolations, gas testing and/or the control of permitry.
- Investigate issues, trips, and incidents.
- Coordinate / organise emergency preparedness planning and exercises in conjunction with emergency service providers, local authorities and Firstgas Ltd.
- Participate in Internal and External Compliance Audits.

This role requires:

- A Bachelor's Degree or suitable Engineering Diploma preferably in Mechanical Engineering (or similar related degree).
- At least 5 years' experience in petrochemical, energy, oil and gas pipelines or related industries. This can be either in maintenance or operations supervisory level.
- Ability to communicate, engage and influence with both internal and external stakeholders.
- Knowledge of Standards and Codes relevant to the position, would be advantageous but is not essential.
