Reporting to the Projects Implementation Manager, the primary function of this role is to design and execute capital projects for Channel Terminal Services.

What will you be doing?

- Coordinating projects across the site, including oversight of project plans to ensure they are completed to schedule and within budget.
- Ensure the impact of project works on customers is minimised and integrated with site operations.
- Assist with the development of long-term project management processes.
- Support cross-functional project teams in the delivery of projects from concept design to implementation.
- Pro-actively manage relationships with internal and external key stakeholders, in particular contractors used to support the capital program.
- Consistently apply management of change and project management controls methodologies to manage team deliverables.
- Ensure work executed meets quality requirements by setting and agreeing performance standards, monitoring against these and taking corrective action when necessary.
- Develop, monitor, review and report performance against suitable KPI's in order to drive continuous improvement for project services provided to clients and stakeholders.
